THE HOLY WEEK IN TARANTO CONSIST OF THREE PROCESSIONS WHICH FOLLOW THE PROLOGUE OF PALM SUNDAY, WHEN THERE ARE THE AUCTIONS AMONG THE CONFRATERNITIES TO GAIN THE SYMBOLS. ON MAUNDY THURSDAY AFTERNOON, THE PAIRS OF CO-BROTHERS (PERDONI) START THEIR PILGRIMAGE, WALKING SLOWLY (NAZZECATE), FROM THE CARMINE CHURCH TO THE CHAPELS OF THE BORGO AND THE OLD TOWN.....



AT THURSDAY MIDNIGHT, THE PROCESSION OF OUR LADY OF SORROW STARTS, ACCOMPANIED BY THE SOUND OF TROCCOLA AND FUNERAL MARCHES AND THE MADONNA'S STATUE IS TAKEN AROUND THE CHURCHES TO LOOK FOR THE SON. THE PROCESSION ENDS THE FOLLOWING MORNING. AT LATE FRIDAY AFTERNOON, THE PROCESSION OF MYSTERIES START WITH THE COFFIN OF DEAD JESUS AND SIX STATUE GROUPS MADE OF WOOD AND PAPER-MACHE'.THE PROCESSION ENDS ON SATURDAY.



EVENT HISTORY

THE RITES DATE BACK TO THE PERIOD OF SPANISH RULE IN SOUTHERN ITALY AND HAVE BEEN INTRODUCED IN TARANTO BY THE PATRICIAN DON DIEGO CALO' WHO, AT THE END OF THE XVII CENTURY, COMMISSIONED STATUES OF THE DEAD JESUS AND OUR LADY OF SORROW IN NAPLES.

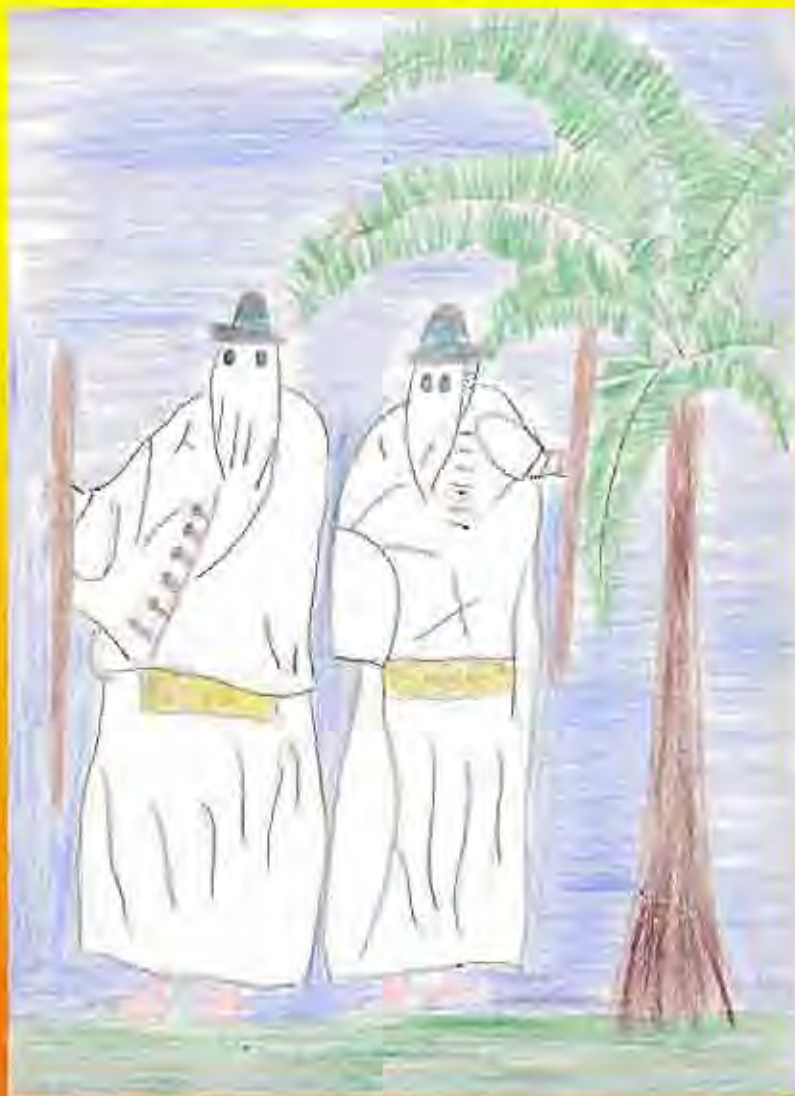

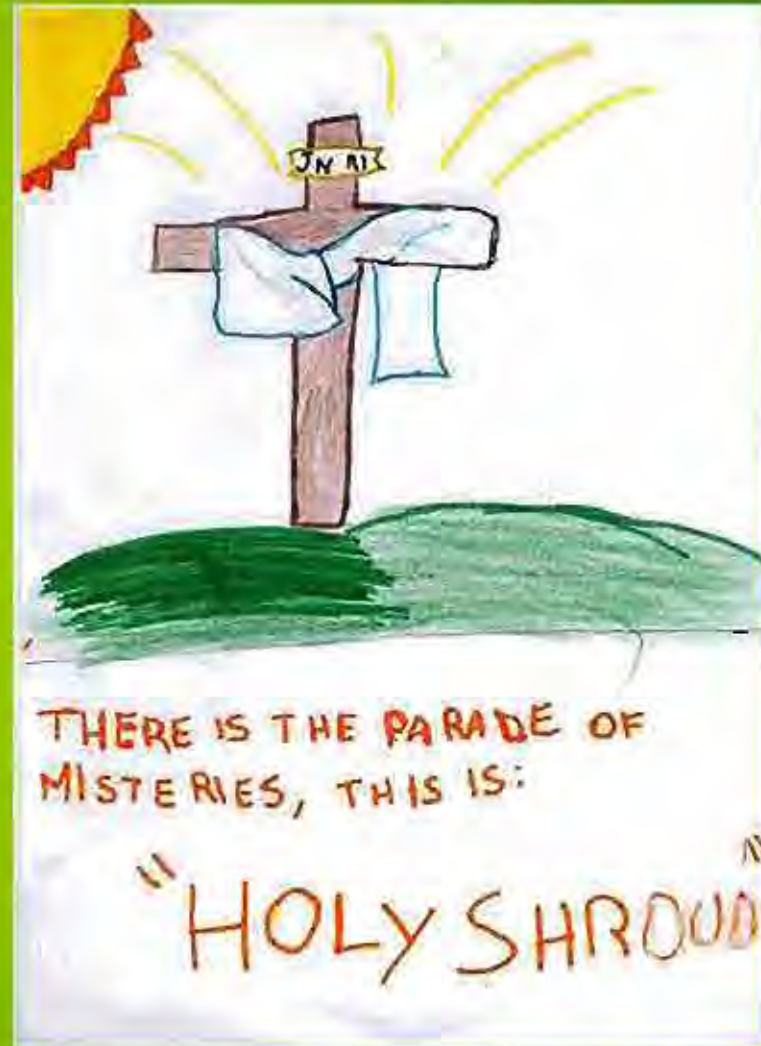
